

Residential Rehabilitation Programs

Bancroft provides a full continuum of residential supports to meet the needs of adults with acquired brain injury from the post-acute hospitalization phase throughout the recovery process. Programs are designed for varying levels of independence and are flexible to accommodate the needs of people recovering from serious neurological injuries.

Services are customized for each person served with assistance ranging from intensive supervision to intermittent staff support.

Residential rehabilitation sites are accessible for individuals with limited mobility. On-site staff support is available for assistance with personal care, eating, mobility and transfers. Supervisory staff provides 24/7 on-call coverage.
